## HOW TO USE THIS MAP:

1. FIND THE LOCATION OF YOUR HOME ON THE MAP TO IDENTIFY YOUR COLOR-CODED ZONE
2. MATCH THE COLOR TO THE CALENDAR

- PLACE ALL ITEMS LOOSE IN CART, **NOT INSIDE BAGS OR BOXES**
- ALL MATERIAL **MUST FIT IN CART**
- PLACE AT LEAST **3 FEET AWAY** FROM ANY OBJECT
- **HANDLES** FACING HOUSE
- **HAVE CART OUT BY 7AM** ON YOUR BI-WEEKLY COLLECTION DAY
- **NO PLASTIC BAGS**

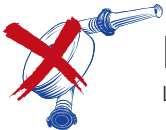


## KNOW YOUR NOs!

### NO TANGLERS

LEAVE OUT ITEMS LIKE HOSES, CORDS, BELTS, AND HOLIDAY LIGHTS.



### NO SCRAP METAL

TAKE MIXED METALS TO YOUR LOCAL CONVENIENCE CENTER.



### NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

LEAVE OUT BUILDING MATERIALS LIKE INSULATION, WOOD, AND CONCRETE.



### NO TEXTILES

DONATE CLOTHING AND TEXTILES TO A LOCAL CHARITY OR THRIFT STORE.



### NO HAZARDOUS OR MEDICAL WASTE
