Charleston County Hosts Conference: So You Want to Start a Nonprofit?

Experts in nonprofit work will speak at day-long conference

<u>Charleston County Government's Community Development Department</u> is hosting a free conference, "So You Want to Start a Nonprofit?" on **Wednesday**, **Sept. 30**, **2015** at The College Center at the Complex for Economic Development at Trident Technical College (Building 920), located at 7000 Rivers Ave. in North Charleston.
