Traffic Alert: Nighttime Lane Closures for the Palmetto Commerce Interchange Project

Charleston County Transportation Development announces lane and shoulder closures on I-26 starting Sunday, January 5. The closures will occur on I-26 between Ashley Phosphate (Exit 209) and US 78 (Exit 205).

- Jan. 5: Left lane closed Westbound from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Jan. 6: Left lane closed Westbound from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Jan. 7: Right shoulder closed Eastbound from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Jan. 8: Right shoulder closed Westbound from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Jan. 9: Right shoulder closed Eastbound from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Jan. 10: Right shoulder closed Westbound from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Located in a rapidly growing area of the Interstate 26 corridor between US 78 (University Boulevard) and Ashley Phosphate Road, the Palmetto Commerce Interchange project is being designed to reduce travel times and improve access options, increase traffic mobility in the I-26/Ashley Phosphate Road area and provide more efficient commute options.
