Charleston County Solid Waste & Recycling Wins Addy Awards for TV Campaigns and Carolina Recycling Association's Award for Sensational Education & Outreach

Charleston County Solid Waste & Recycling recently received two Bronze Addy Awards for its 2006 educational TV ad campaigns from the Advertising Federation of Charleston. The awards were presented to Charleston County Solid Waste & Recycling at the local 2007 Addy Awards Gala held at the Charleston Place hotel.

Charleston County Solid Waste & Recycling and its production company, Osprey Productions HD, received one award for a 30-second, anti-litter commercial about illegal dumping titled "Do the Right Thing and Put it Where it Belongs."

The other Bronze Award was given for the "Get in the Game and Put it Where it Belongs" recycling campaign, which included three TV commercials featuring the Charleston Stingrays, RiverDogs and Battery local sports teams.
