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Charleston County Council Recognizes 26 Small/Disadvantaged Business Owners Who Completed Nine-Week Course

During a regular meeting on Tuesday, Jan. 25, <u>Charleston County Council</u> hosted a recognition ceremony for 26 local business owners who completed the Turner School of Construction Management. Each recipient has previously received certificates from Charleston County, <u>State Sen. Robert Ford</u>, and <u>State Rep. Wendell G.</u> Gilliard.

The purpose of the ceremony was to recognize the local Small Business Enterprises (SBE's) Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's) for completing the nine-week Turner School of Construction Management class. Turner Construction provided the class free of charge to small businesses so they could learn how to develop a business plan, estimate and bid larger jobs, obtain bonding, enforce safety principles and establish and manage credit.
