Traffic Alerts: Nighttime Lane Closures on Bowman Road

Minor delays expected as part of Johnnie Dodds Boulevard Improvements Project

[Charleston County Government](#) announces road work as part of the [Johnnie Dodds Boulevard Improvements Project](#) in Mount Pleasant.

Lane closures at Bowman Road and East Frontage Road:

- From March 23 – April 9, drivers should expect minor, nighttime delays from 9 p.m. – 6 a.m. due to east-bound and west-bound lane closures of Bowman Road near the East Frontage Road intersection (by McDonald's restaurant).
- Traffic turning from Johnnie Dodds Boulevard onto Bowman Road will be shifted over to the adjacent lane, which will be marked with construction cones.
- Depending on the weather, a crew will be installing storm drainage pipes for approximately two weeks.

Lane closures at Bowman Road and West Frontage Road:

- From March 23 - April 9, drivers should expect minor, nighttime delays from 9 p.m. – 6 a.m. on Bowman Road due to east-bound and west-bound lane closures near the West Frontage Road intersection (by Arby's restaurant).
- The construction area will be marked with construction cones.
- Depending on the weather, a crew will be installing storm drainage pipes at this intersection for approximately two weeks.

At no time during either closure will Bowman Road be closed to traffic. Drivers traveling through the project area are asked to be aware of equipment and crews working in the area. Alternative routes are recommended if possible. The public is also asked to notice traffic control signs, reductions in speed limit and message board information, and to note that all road work is dependent on the weather.

Background information on the project:

- The goal of the project, which is expected to be completed in the fall of 2012, is to improve the traffic flow in and out of Mount Pleasant, especially before and after school and work hours.
- The project is funded by the [Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax](#) and managed by [Charleston County Government's RoadWise Program](#), in close coordination with the [Town of Mount Pleasant](#) and the [S.C. Department of Transportation](#).
- Drivers traveling through the project area are asked to be aware of equipment and crews working in the area. Alternative routes are recommended if possible. The public is also asked to notice traffic control signs, reductions in speed limit and message board information, and to note that all road work is dependent on the weather. Every effort is being made to schedule necessary lane closures for the project during off- peak, nighttime and weekend hours when possible.
