Traffic Alert: Daytime Lane Closures on West Frontage Road in Mount Pleasant for One Month

[Charleston County Government](#) announces additional lane closures as part of continuing road work on the [Johnnie Dodds Boulevard Improvements Project](#) in Mount Pleasant. The lane closures will affect West Frontage Road.

April 11 - May 11: Daytime lane closures on West Frontage Road:

- Road crews will temporarily close a lane on West Frontage Road Bowman Road and Anna Knapp Boulevard (from Parks Auto Parts to the Arby's restaurant entrance).
- Construction activity will occur from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Drivers will have access to businesses along West Frontage Road at all times during construction.
- The work is necessary for crews to install underground drainage pipes.

Background information on the project:

- The goal of the project, which is expected to be completed in the fall of 2012, is to improve the traffic flow in and out of Mount Pleasant, especially before and after school and work hours.
- The project is funded by the [Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax](#) and managed by [Charleston County Government's](#) RoadWise Program, in close coordination with the [Town of Mount Pleasant](#) and the [S.C. Department of Transportation](#).
- Drivers traveling through the project area are asked to be aware of equipment and crews working in the area. Alternative routes are recommended if possible. The public is also asked to notice traffic control signs, reductions in speed limit and message board information, and to note that all road work is dependent on the weather. Every effort is being made to schedule necessary lane closures for the project during off-peak, nighttime and weekend hours when possible.
