# **Construction Complete on Five Transportation Sales Tax Projects**

Pedestrian, drainage, paving and intersection improvement projects completed throughout County

<u>Charleston County Government</u> announces that construction is complete on five projects that were funded by the Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax:

#### Center Street Intersection/Pedestrian Improvement Project on Folly Beach:

- The improvements were designed to enhance visibility and safety of the crosswalks as well as the streetscape along Center Street.
- Brick-patterned crosswalks were installed along Center Street at three intersections
- A curb ramp was replaced to provide proper access to all pedestrians and to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.
- The project was funded by the Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax.
- <u>Charleston County Council</u> approved the project as a part of its 2011 <u>Transportation Sales</u> <u>Tax annual allocations</u> for intersection improvement projects.

#### Memminger Hall Subdivision Drainage Improvement Project in West Ashley:

- The project provided new a storm drainage system to alleviate flooding that was occurring along Memory Lane.
- New drainage pipe and inlets were installed.
- The roadway was resurfaced
- <u>Charleston County Council</u> approved the project as a part of its 2009 Transportation Sales Tax annual allocations for public works projects.

#### Farmfield Avenue Multiuse Path Project in West Ashley:

- The project provided a new eight-foot, concrete, multiuse path along Farmfield Avenue from Savannah Highway to the West Ashley Greenway.
- The improvements included the installation of the new path and new storm water drainage pipe with inlets along the roadway.
- <u>Charleston County Council</u> approved the project as a part of its 2010 Transportation Sales Tax annual allocations for bike and pedestrian improvement projects.

### Marlin Road Improvement Project in the City of Charleston on Johns Island:
