Construction Complete on 2 of 4 phases for Fort Johnson Road Sidewalks

Crews complete Phases 1 and 2 of sidewalks funded by the Transportation Sales Tax

<u>Charleston County Government</u> announces the completion of two of four phases of new sidewalks along Fort Johnson Road on James Island. All phases are funded by the <u>Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax Program</u> and approved by <u>Charleston County Council</u> as a part of its Transportation Sales Tax Annual Allocations Program.

Details of the completed phases:

- <u>Phase 1</u> of the project included the construction of a new sidewalk (some areas asphalt and some concrete) from <u>James Island Charter High School</u> and to Lighthouse Boulevard.
- <u>Phase 2</u> of the project included the construction of a new, asphalt sidewalk beginning at Walkers Landing Lane and continuing to the entrance to the <u>S.C. Department of Natural</u> Resources' Marine Resources Division.

Details of future Phase 3 and Phase 4:

- <u>Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax Program</u> staff continues to work with the <u>S.C. Department of Transportation</u>, the <u>City of Charleston</u> and residents on the design of the last two phases of sidewalk.
- The goal of Phase 3 and Phase 4 is to provide sidewalk connectivity along the full length of Fort Johnson Road from the <u>S.C. Department of Natural Resources</u> <u>Marine Resources</u> <u>Division</u> to <u>Folly Road</u>.
