Transportation Sales Tax to Fund Stiles Point Elementary School Sidewalk

Preliminary work begins this week and construction will start this fall

<u>Charleston County Government</u> announces the start of a new sidewalk project on James Island to serve the <u>Stiles Point Elementary School</u> complex.

The County worked with the <u>Charleston County School District</u> to define the project, and mailed letters to property owners in the project area notifying them that survey and design work is beginning. The field survey will begin this week and construction is scheduled to begin in the fall.

Project details:

- Construct a sidewalk and make drainage improvements along the north side of Godber Street from Stiles Drive to Mikell Drive.
- Add a crosswalk across Mikell Drive that will connect to a <u>South Carolina Safe Routes to</u> <u>School</u> sidewalk project that will continue the Godber Street sidewalk from Mikell Drive to Mooring Drive.

The \$300,000 project will be funded by the <u>Charleston County Transportation Sales Tax Program</u> and was approved by <u>Charleston County Council</u> as a part of its <u>Transportation Sales Tax Annual</u> <u>Allocations Program</u>.
