Charleston County Government Update

Charleston County will move to Operating Condition (OPCON) 3 at 4:00 p.m. today. OPCON 3 means a disaster or emergency situation is likely or imminent. Charleston County will activate the Emergency Operations Center at that time.

<u>Charleston County Government</u> offices closed at 12:00 today and all offices will remain closed for Wednesday, January 29.

Other important closing information:

- Charleston County Council is cancelled for Tuesday January 28 rescheduled for 5:00 p.m. on Thursday January 30.
- The Judicial Complex will close at noon today and the complex will be closed Wednesday, January 29
- The Charleston Center will close at noon today and remain closed for Wednesday, January 29.
- The ZLDR Public Hearing (St. Andrews Overlay District) scheduled for Tuesday January 28 is cancelled, rescheduled for 6:30 on Tuesday, February 25.
- Charleston County Employee Recognition ceremony schedule for Wednesday January 29 is cancelled.
- Charleston County Public Library branches and book drops will be closed Wednesday January 29 due to
