Traffic Alert: Park Circle in North Charleston to be Closed for Resurfacing

[Charleston County Government](#) announces that Park Circle will be closed to traffic on the night of Sunday, Nov. 2, 2014 as well as during the off-peak hours on Monday, Nov. 3, 2014 to allow crews to resurface the roadway. All work is weather permitting.

November 2 (Sunday night):

- Park Circle will be closed and all traffic will be detoured along Park Place to allow crews to mill off the existing pavement.
- The work will occur between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

November 3 (Monday daytime):

- Park Circle will be closed during the off-peak traffic hours and all traffic will be detoured along Park Place to allow crews to place the new pavement.
- The work will occur between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Citizens traveling in this area should expect to see construction equipment and crews working on Park Circle. Signs will be posted to close Park Circle and direct traffic along Park Place.

The resurfacing of Park Circle is part of the [Charleston CTC](#) FY 2014 Resurfacing Project that is being managed by Charleston County Transportation Development.
