Charleston County Council Names Keith Bustraan as New Administrator

Bustraan has served as Interim Administrator since April

On Tuesday night, Charleston County Council voted to make Keith Bustraan the new Charleston County Administrator. As former Deputy Administrator of Finance, Bustraan has been working as the Interim Administrator for the last eight weeks.

"I'm looking forward to working with Mr. Bustraan as the new Charleston County Administrator," said County Council Chairman Elliott Summey. "Mr. Bustraan has served in multiple roles with the County, especially as it relates to the county's finances and we expect him to excel in his new role."

Keith Bustraan has been with Charleston County for 28 years. Under his leadership, both the Budget Office and Finance Department have won national awards through the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA).
