Are you interested in seeing your artwork displayed across Charleston County?

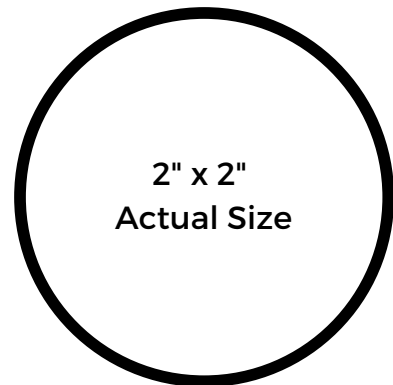
The Charleston County Board of Voter Registration and Elections is offering Charleston County students in grades K-12 the opportunity to design our next "I Voted!" sticker.
