



Emergency Polling Location Change for Charleston County Sheriff Republican Primary Runoff Election

An emergency polling location change is being implemented for the Charleston County Sheriff Republican Primary Runoff Election on Tuesday, June 25, 2024.

The following, temporary change will be in effect:

- Mt. Pleasant 3, Mt. Pleasant 15, and Mt. Pleasant 16 at the Mount Pleasant National Guard Armory moved to:
Town of Mount Pleasant Municipal Complex - 100 Ann Edwards Lane – Mt. Pleasant, S.C. 29464

A previously announced polling location change for Mt. Pleasant 1 voters, who will now vote at Miram Brown Community Center at 118 Royall Avenue, is also in effect for the runoff election.

Eligible residents can utilize the runoff election's early voting period from Wednesday, June 19, 2024 through Friday, June 21, 2024. Early voting hours are from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. each day. Eligible residents may vote early at any of the three early voting centers:

Absentee ballots are being sent to those who have previously requested them in the event of a runoff. All completed absentee ballots must be received by BVRE headquarters by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

The Charleston County Board of Voter Registration and Elections is responsible for conducting all municipal, state, and federal elections that are held in Charleston County. BVRE also conducts outreach events with community members that encourage election education and participation.
