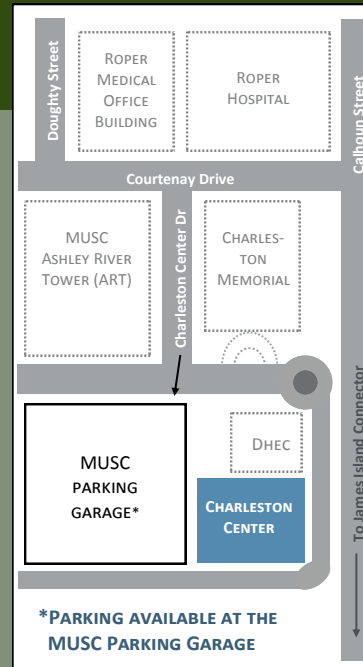
Charleston Center offers a wide variety of packaged programs to meet community needs.

Cost of Services

- ⇒ A list of fees is available upon request.
- ⇒ Payment in full is expected at time of services, although payment plans can be arranged.
- ⇒ We accept Insurance and Medicaid.
- ⇒ Services will not be denied if a client meets the Federal Poverty Guidelines and is unable to pay.
- ⇒ A financial assessment will be completed at intake to determine eligibility.

Charleston Center offers a continuum of care for adult and women's services.

Charleston Center's counseling staff consists of a diverse group of licensed and certified professionals.

Inpatient Services

Charleston Center offers Inpatient Detoxification, Transitional Care and New Life services.

- ⇒ Detoxification services include medically and clinically managed treatment for adults who are withdrawing from alcohol and other drugs.
- ⇒ Transitional Care Unit offers 24-hour medically monitored treatment services for adults who require continuous therapeutic care in recovery from chemical dependency.
- ⇒ New Life Unit provides medically monitored care for pregnant and parenting women who are chemically dependent. Women can bring two children (ages newborn to 5 years) who will be cared for through Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS) program.

Outpatient Services

Outpatient Services are provided in a variety of confidential, comfortable and convenient formats.

Individual and group counseling is available, including evening sessions to accommodate work or school schedules.

Special programs are available for Adolescents, Women and Persons Incarcerated Entering Recovery (PIER).

Methadone/Suboxone Services

Opiate addiction (heroin, prescription pain medicine, etc.) is one of the most difficult physical addictions and requires medication maintenance during treatment. Charleston Center offers Methadone and Suboxone combined with clinical counseling for clients.

Prevention/Education Services

Charleston Center's Prevention department works with schools, coalition and community organizations to provide alcohol and drug education, and risk reduction activities.

Prevention programs include Palmetto Retailers Education Program (PREP), Tobacco Education Program (TEP) and All Stars curriculum.

Speakers for community and school events are available at no charge.

ADSAP Services

The Alcohol and Drug Safety Action Program (ADSAP) offers education and treatment services for persons required to complete ADSAP due to a DUAC/DUI/BUI conviction, or who have had their driver's license suspended due to the ALR or Zero Tolerance Laws.

Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS)

TBS is a child development program designed to meet the needs of children who may have developmental delays due to the alcohol and drug use of their parents.
