REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about August 19, 2024 the County of Charleston will submit a request to the HUD for the release of HOME funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383), as amended, to undertake a project known as new construction of up to fourteen (14) single-family, affordable housing dwellings for the purpose of homeownership and providing safety, mobility, and a healthier community within Hollywood. The estimate of the overall project is \$2,841,663 with \$70,000 in HOME PY23 Funds. The Projects location will be Hollytree Drive, Hollywood, Charleston County, SC.

HUD will accept objections to its release of fund and the County of Charleston certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the County of Charleston; (b) the County of Charleston has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality.
