Charleston County and Fetter Health Care Vaccinate more than 1900 Citizens

Charleston County, in partnership with the Library and Fetter Health Care Network, have vaccinated 1,945 citizens at our rural vaccination clinic sites.

“We’re very excited we have reached so many citizens in our rural communities,” said Emergency Management Director Jason Patno. “This effort would not have been possible without the Charleston County Public Library and Fetter Health Care Network. We are currently working to schedule additional clinics and we ask that citizens be patient as we are trying to get out to as many communities as possible.”

Rural Vaccination Clinic: Those who received the first Moderna vaccine at the Baxter-Patrick James Island Library on February 25 are **guaranteed** a second dose and do not need to schedule an appointment or arrive before 9 a.m.

Parking will be available for citizens receiving the Johnson & Johnson vaccine beginning at 12:30 p.m. The clinic is first come, first serve until capacity is reached.

The library will be closed to the public on the day of the vaccine clinics. The book drops will also be closed. Charleston County plans to continue working with Fetter Health Care on future rural clinics as the COVID-19 vaccine becomes available.
