New Traffic Pattern on Glenn McConnell Parkway

On Friday, March 22 crews will begin to open the new traffic lanes on Glenn McConnell Parkway in West Ashley. Crews will begin pulling the orange barrels on the third travel lanes in each direction of Glenn McConnell Friday morning. It will take several hours, and they will work against the flow of traffic in each direction. After the cones are pulled, the project will be considered substantially complete. Drivers will notice crews continuing to work on landscaping.

"I am thrilled this project is being completed on time and within the budget," said Councilmember Brantley Moody. "We appreciate this community's patience as our team worked diligently to improve traffic flow, safety, and add pedestrian upgrades to the project area."

"It is wonderful to see this project come to fruition," said Councilmember Kylon Middleton. "I know residents have been eagerly awaiting the opening of the new lanes to help ease traffic in this heavily traveled area."

The project includes improvements along an approximately 2.1-mile section of Glenn McConnell Parkway starting near Magwood Drive to the intersection with Bees Ferry Road. The primary goal is to relieve traffic congestion on Glenn McConnell Parkway and improve bike/pedestrian access throughout the project corridor.
