

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE 2024-2025 BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 2296, TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCREASE OF ST. PAUL'S FIRE DISTRICT'S GENERAL FUND BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$584,699 FOR THE FISCALYEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2025, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS FISCAL YEAR 2025; TO PROVIDE FOR BUDGETARY CONTROL OF SAID APPROPRIATIONS BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, Charleston County Council enacted Ordinance Number 2296 on June 18, 2024, which provided approval of the Fiscal Year 2025 budget for the St. Paul's Fire District, and

WHEREAS, the District has requested a revision to the budget ordinance, and

WHEREAS, as provided in Ordinance Number 2296, County Council must approve an amendment to said Budget Ordinance when fund totals are adjusted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY CHARLESTON COUNTY COUNCIL that Charleston County Ordinance No. 2296 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

Section 2 is amended by increasing the General Fund budget amount for the St. Paul's Fire District by \$584,699 so that Section 2 shall read as follows:

That the General Fund budgets of the Agencies listed below are hereby approved for the corresponding amounts by Charleston County Council:

Cooper River Park & Playground Commission	227,157
North Charleston District	1,434,791
St. Andrew's Parish Parks & Playground Commission	5,185,346
St. John's Fire District	20,562,254
St. Paul's Fire District	9,790,304

SECTION 2: If any provision of this Ordinance or its applications to any circumstance is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, this holding shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared by Council to be severable.

SECTION 3: The remainder of the original Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect following approval of third reading.
